PLAZA PATIO Opens on BART Plaza

Our latest activation, the PLAZA PATIO opened November 21, a wonderful eating experience in BART Plaza, the heart of our bustling Downtown. The PLAZA PATIO is a shared **pop-up outdoor dining space** for BART Plaza merchants and their customers: *Coffee Hut, Sliver Pizzeria, IKE's Love & Sandwiches, Almare Gelato and*



MIXT Greens. The Patio is dedicated, well-maintained area to enjoy delectable food and/or drink from any of the merchants in the Plaza. Downtown Berkeley Ambassadors set-up the PLAZA PATIO each weekday morning, and put away each evening, except on days of special events using the entire Plaza. The DBA assisted the Coffee Hut in applying for an Sidewalk Seating Outdoor Commerce permit with the City of Berkeley to make the PLAZA PATIO possible. TRASH CABINET Pilot Program Goes Live on Shattuck @ Addison



On November 9, after two years of development, the Trash Cabinet pilot program finally went operational on Shattuck just south of Addison, serving four merchants: *Happy Lemon, Sushi Secrets, For Eyes, and What the Cluck.*For years the Downtown has struggled with the challenge of garbage bins (trash, recycling & compost) left haphazardly on the sidewalk, often overflowing, or rummaged through also. After evaluating several off-the-shelf products, the DBA, working with City, commissioned this new design with metalworker Alex Nolan. The Zero Waste Dept. particularly wanted a single easy-open door to access an entire row of trash bins. We also wanted a transparent design with easy

visibility of what is inside and on the other side of cabinet, a core principle of Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design. The roughly \$20,000 project was co-funded 50% by the City of Berkeley, 25% by the DBA, and another 25% by the property owner housing the four tenants. If the pilot program is successful, we hope it can be a model for neat and clean trash bins elsewhere in the Downtown and throughout Berkeley!

Lexie's Frozen Custard Opens on Addison St in Arts District

UC Berkeley Volunteers Spruce Up South End of District
